Concurrent high school students must be eligible to satisfy the high school curricular requirements for college admission no later than the spring of their senior year. A high school student admitted under the provisions set forth below may enroll in a combined number of high school and college courses per semester not to exceed a full-time college work load of 19 semester credit-hours. A high school student may enroll in a maximum of 9 semester credit-hours during a summer session following the end of his/her junior year of high school. A high school student must meet the following requirements for admission:

- A. The student must have taken the ACT test:  
**Seniors** must have an ACT composite score of 19 and ACT of 19 in the area of enrollment or a 3.00 GPA and a 19 ACT in the area of enrollment.  
**Juniors** must have an ACT composite score of 21 and a 19 ACT in the area of enrollment or a 3.50 GPA and a 19 ACT in the area of enrollment
- B. The student cannot enroll in zero-level or remedial courses.
- C. The student must maintain a grade point average of 2.00 on 4.00 scale to be eligible for continued concurrent enrollment.
- D. A copy of the student's high-school transcript and ACT scores must accompany the concurrent form.

I have read and understand the provisions as set forth by Northern Oklahoma College for my concurrent enrollment. I accept the condition that I must be concurrently enrolled in high school for my college enrollment to be valid. I also understand that I must submit a complete, official transcript from my high school showing high school graduation if I continue my attendance after graduation. My enrollment will be accepted by Northern Oklahoma College upon payment of fees and the submission of all the information requested above. I understand that student records are released only in accordance with institutional policy as provided by the Family Educational Tights and Privacy Act (as amended). Northern reserves the right to cancel classes.

All new students must pay a \$25 application fee. This is a one-time, non-refundable fee charged to a student's first enrollment. In conjunction with the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, Northern will continue to participate in the pilot program for concurrent enrollment. NOC will provide tuition waivers to all qualified high school seniors for the summer 2007, fall 2007 and spring 2008 semesters. Under this pilot program, high school seniors are eligible to receive a resident tuition waiver for up to six (6) credit hours per semester. Tuition waivers will apply to regularly scheduled courses offered by Northern Oklahoma College, either on campus or through interactive television. Online instruction delivered via the Internet is limited to a tuition waiver of \$77.50 (*rates subject to change*) per credit hour for concurrent students. The remaining tuition and fees must be paid by the student. To retain this tuition waiver for the spring semester, recipients must maintain a grade-point average of 2.00.
