Classroom Rules (The 6 Ps)

1. BE: Polite, Prepared, Prompt, Productive, Positive, & a Participant

CONSEQUENCES:

- 1. Verbal warning
- 2. Writing assignment (may be paragraphs, copying from text, or writing a report over a famous mathematician.)
- 3. Double writing assignment
- 4. Discipline referral to the office.

CLASSROOM PROCEDURES

- 1. Before class: Go to the restroom and get a drink.
- 2. Entering classroom: Enter quietly and calmly. Sharpen pencil. Be seated and place homework on your desk before tardy bell. Then, begin the daily warm-up problem posted on the SMART board. Work individually on these problems. Once everyone is finished we will review the answers to these problems as well as any homework questions. Homework will then be passed in to be graded.
- 3. During class: Take notes! Ask questions! If you do not understand something while I am lecturing, please stop me and ask me to repeat or review. Do not wait until the end of the class to tell me you didn't understand the very first thing I said. There are no stupid questions. There is most likely someone else with your same questions, so just ask!
- 4. End of class: I dismiss class, not the bell! Once everyone is seated and quiet, class will be dismissed.
