- --- All students will be provided a hard copy of the district policy EHBDB Parental Involvement Policy and school site procedure for carrying out the policy within the first 10 school days of each school year. These copies shall be placed in the parent folders of each student to be delivered to their parents.
- --- Pre-Enrollment hosted school wide in the summer prior to school shall provide all parents with the proper procedure to file concerns and provide a basic framework to understand the curriculum that will be provided and avenues in which parents can help determine that curriculum.
- --- "Parent University" hosted school wide the evening school begins to allow parents to meet/communicate initial concerns or possible barriers to student learning as perceived by the parent. Parents will also be provided information concerning the current Title I program and an explanation of the curriculum in use, the forms of academic assessment used to measure progress, and the proficiency levels of students.
- ---Quarterly "Reading Nights" which consist of evening opportunities for parents to come to the school library and read with their student, meet/communicate with teachers, provide input concerning obstacles to learning that parents may be encountering.
- --- A text messaging system will be used to communicate perceived barriers as they occur within the context of the students learning and allow parents an immediate avenue to collaborate with their child's teacher concerning their education. This messaging system will be designed to allow direct response to teacher concerns for parents. Teachers shall remain diligent in responding to parent concerns and successfully communicate their concerns to parents.
